The Scholarship Committee requests a relatively brief autobiography of the application which would include his conversion experience and any references to a "call" to special service, along with personal plans for the future in a church-related vocation. This autobiography should include experience in church related work.

20. Requirements and Explanations:

- (a) The Mr. and Mrs. Harold H. Schooler Scholarships are granted to students who have a "clear" call to the ministry or Church related vocation to attend any Southern Baptist school, or MSSU, Joplin, or a school approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- (b) Awarding a scholarship is based primarily on need plus personal qualification. The applicant must come well recommended by his pastor and his home church. (Applicant will see to it that a letter of commendation, in addition to the references above, is sent to the Committee from the pastor or some other responsible person of the applicant's home church.)
- (c) Continuation of scholarship will depend on a favorable report from the school concerning grades and conduct. (The applicant will see to it that this is sent to the Committee at the conclusion of the 1st semester, or just prior to the time for the last half of the year's scholarship.)
- (d) Scholarship checks will be made jointly to the student and the school he is to attend. The second half of the scholarship will be forwarded prior to the beginning of the second half of the school year, following a favorable report from an official of the school concerning the student.
- (e) Each scholarship shall be in the amount determined by the Committee upon evaluation of the application, for the academic school year, payable as indicated under "c" and "d" above.
- (f) The application and all related items must be in the possession of the scholarship committee by March 1. The Committee will make an effort to notify the applicants of the awards by May 15.
- (g) Upon signing this application, the applicant commits himself to use any money received from this scholarship fund for the exclusive purpose of furthering his education as indicated in this application.
- (h) Upon the receipt of the scholarship a thank you letter should be written to the Schooler Family and sent to Spring River Baptist Association.
