Camp Dress Code:

Ladies:

- Modest 1-piece swimsuit or a 2-piece with no stomach showing (T-shirt and shorts for a cover up to and from the pool)
- No spaghetti strap tank tops, crop tops, or low cut shirts.
- Shorts must be finger-tip length. No biker/spandex shorts outside of dorms.
- Dresses and skirts must be below the knees or longer.
- No undergarments or midsections showing.
- If wearing leggings, the shirt needs to be finger tip.
- No distressed jeans with excessive rips.

Boys:

- Shirts on at all times, unless swimming.
- No cutoff shirts.
- No clothing displaying questionable content.(Such as references to alcohol, drugs, or girls.)
- Must wear a shirt going to and from the pool.
- No distressed jeans with excessive rips.

Faculty and staff have the right to change dress code as they feel appropriate.

The camp director and staff will be the final authority on all dress code issues.

Rules & Regulations

The purpose of these guidelines is not to restrict comfort or personal style, but to encourage our campers to reflect Christ in every aspect of their lives, including their outward appearance. Our desire is to challenge each camper to be mindful of how they represent their faith to others and embrace the opportunity to live set apart. As followers of Christ, we are called to glorify Him in all that we do—including the way we dress.

1. Each Camper must agree to abide by the dress code at all times.
2. The daily schedule must be observed by everyone. Attendance at all camp activities is required of all campers unless granted permission by camp director or Camp Counselor.
3. No one is allowed to leave the campgrounds without specific permission by camp director.
4. The possession or use of a vape pen, tobacco, drugs, or alcohol is forbidden and will result in dismissal.
5. No firearms, knives, or articles of clothing displaying questionable content are allowed.
6. We reserve the right to inspect contents of all personal belongings. The holding and/or disposal of improper contents is the rights of the camp.
7. No camper will be allowed in ANY other dorm room than the one to which they are assigned.
8. There is to be no food or drink in the Chapel. (Water is allowed)
9. All staff members are authorized to maintain order anywhere on the grounds.
10. NO PDA (Includes the holding of hands.)
11. Each camper will perform his/her duties as part of the privilege of being at camp. Rooms/ adjacent grounds must be kept clean daily.
12. You are urged and expected to observe habits of person cleanliness, courtesy, and Christian conduct.
- 13. All medications, prescriptions and over the counter drugs must be brought in the original bottle to the camp nurse upon arrival.**
14. Profanity is not allowed!
